

**PHIL 5360 Seminar on Continental European Philosophy:
Life-world, History and the New Path to Transcendental
Phenomenology in Husserl's *Crisis***

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Class presentation and discussion: 30%; Short Essay: 20%; Final Essay: 50%

A. Objective

This seminar proposes to examine the methodological and thematic innovations in the last great work of Edmund Husserl (1859-1938) : *The Crisis of European Sciences and Transcendental Phenomenology*. This consists basically of an intensive and close study of the *Crisis* text. This will be preceded by an overview of Husserl's early philosophical development, namely: the explanation of Husserl's Idea of phenomenological philosophy as a rigorous science, the phenomenological break-through in the *Logical Investigations*, the mature formulation of the method and task of transcendental phenomenology in the *Cartesian Meditations*. The contribution of *Crisis* to the later development of the phenomenological movement as well as its persistent influence in the humanities and the social sciences will be highlighted. Discussions and analyses will be conducted in close connection to Husserl's texts. Whereas English translations will basically be used, constant reference to the German original and existing Chinese translations will be made.
