內容綜覽

This course is a small-class 'problem-oriented' seminar. It is designed for second-year major students to develop an ability to analyze and reflect on contemporary human conditions from a philosophical perspective. Main topics may include: life and death; the meaning of life; faiths and religions; human's place in nature; self, freedom, and rights; technological revolution and human alienation; love and friendship.

Advisory: For Majors (4-year curriculum) only; to be taken in year 2.

- 1) Understand contemporary human conditions from a philosophical point of view.
- 2) Develop own critical views on the meanings and values of life.
- 3) Research further the issues taught.
- 4) Learn how to reason and argue cogently in group discussions and debates.

課程編排

- 1. 課程初期(約佔2-3堂):教師爲小組報告作示範,並與學員商議小組報告題目及細節。學員可就其關心之人生問題、社會文化現象或世界危機等構思報告題目,教師於構思過程中給予指導。
- 2. 小組報告及討論(約佔6-7堂):學員二人一組,全班分爲6-7組。
- 3. 文章討論(約佔5堂): 教師因應課程內容選取若干哲學文章予學員閱讀並討論。
