### **Philosophy and Human Conditions (2<sup>nd</sup> term 2013-14)**

#### **內容綜覽**

This course is a small-class ‘problem-oriented’ seminar. It is designed for second-year major students to develop an ability to analyze and reflect on contemporary human conditions from a philosophical perspective. Main topics may include: life and death; the meaning of life; faiths and religions; human’s place in nature; self, freedom, and rights; technological revolution and human alienation; love and friendship.

Advisory: For Majors (4-year curriculum) only; to be taken in year 2.

#### **學習成果**

- 1) Understand contemporary human conditions from a philosophical point of view.
- 2) Develop own critical views on the meanings and values of life.
- 3) Research further the issues taught.
- 4) Learn how to reason and argue cogently in group discussions and debates.

#### **課程編排**

1. 課程初期 (約佔 2 – 3 堂)：教師為小組報告作示範，並與學員商議小組報告題目及細節。學員可就其關心之人生問題、社會文化現象或世界危機等構思報告題目，教師於構思過程中給予指導。
2. 小組報告及討論 (約佔 6 – 7 堂)：學員二人一組，全班分為 6 – 7 組。
3. 文章討論 (約佔 5 堂)：教師因應課程內容選取若干哲學文章予學員閱讀並討論。
