此課程旨在介紹傳統中國文化及其哲學基礎,探索中國文化的源流,先秦中國的百家爭鳴以及漢代以來的儒釋道的思想互動。在先秦百家的哲學觀念中,著重介紹儒家、道家、墨家與法家,探討諸多思想對於後世的傳統中國政治、社會與家庭生活的影響。本課程鼓勵學生在文學、藝術、電影、飲食、建築等領域廣泛地搜尋傳統文化因素,反思傳統文化對於當今的現實生活世界的影響。
